1 Getting Started With Otezla

- Ask your doctor what you could expect Otezla to do for you and when you should start to see results
- Review with your doctor your Otezla treatment plan, as well as common side effects and ways to manage
- Create a care team list (eg, your doctor, the specialty pharmacy that supplies your Otezla, etc)



2 Addressing Your Financial Support

3 Understanding How to Get Otezla

- Your specialty pharmacy will give you a call to schedule your Otezla delivery. Watch for a call from an unknown number—it may be them trying to reach you—save their number in your phone for next time
- If you have an Otezla \$0 Co-Pay Card, tell your specialty pharmacy when they call
- Schedule your delivery for a time that works best for you



4 Establishing a Treatment Routine

- Download GOtezla®—a free app to track your symptoms, chart your progress with photos, set up medication reminders, get helpful tips, and more



- Set up refill reminders on your calendar and contact your specialty pharmacy to schedule monthly refills



5 Evaluating Your Otezla Treatment

- Track your results and share them with your doctor

Behind the Scenes

1. The specialty pharmacy is notified of your prescription by your doctor and works with your insurance provider to confirm coverage and prescription costs.

2. If eligible, your Otezla \$0 Co-Pay Card is shipped to you by Otezla SupportPlus™. Allow 2-3 days for your card to arrive.

3. If you have a Co-Pay Card, your benefit is applied automatically. Otezla is then shipped to you by your specialty pharmacy.
